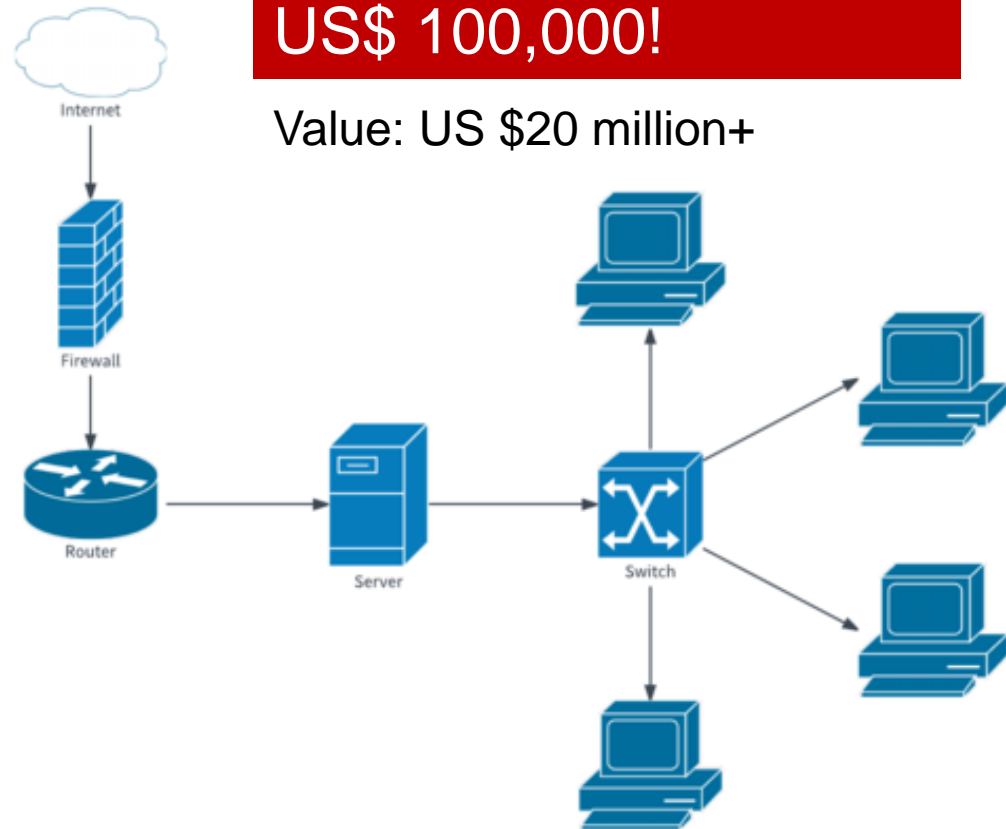

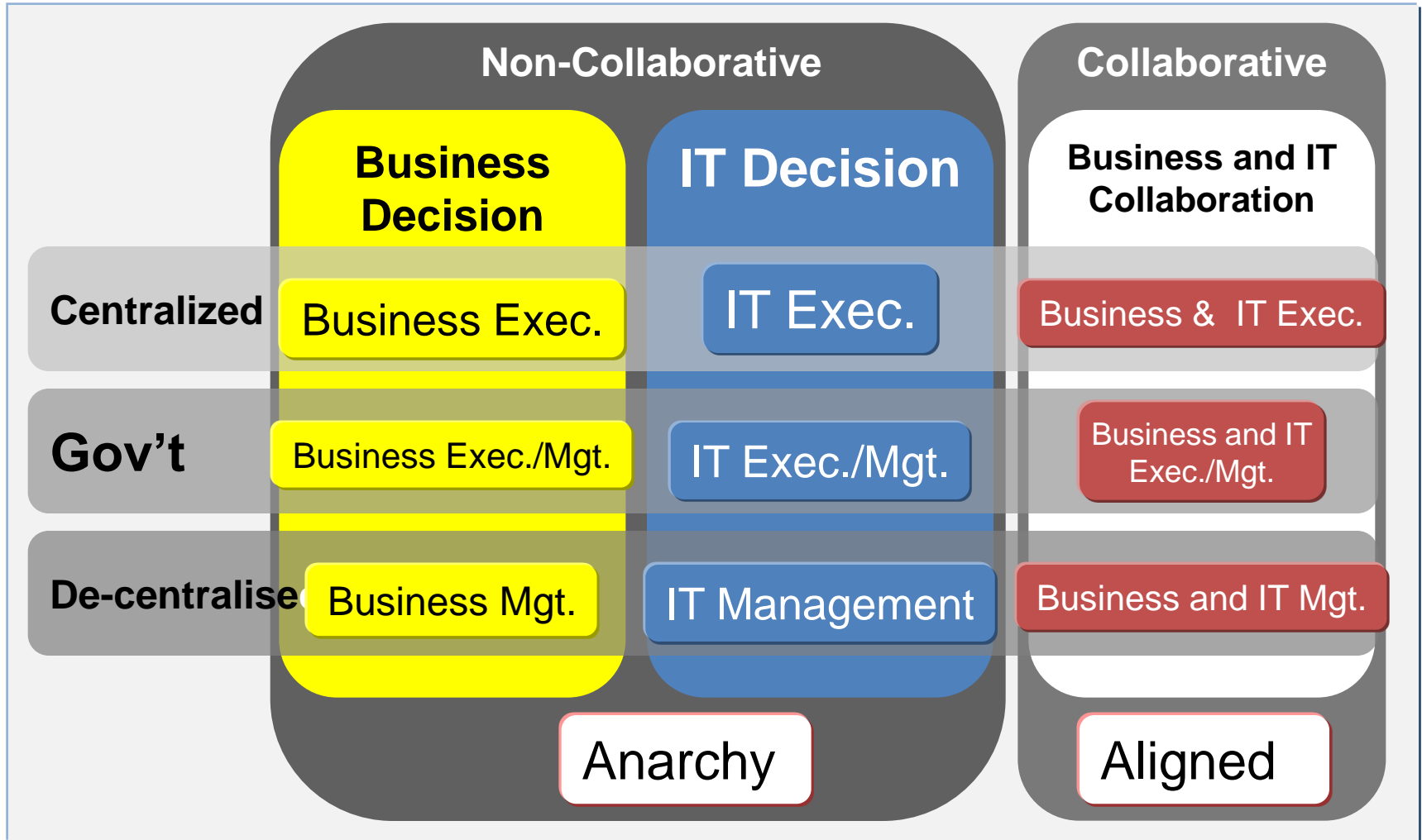

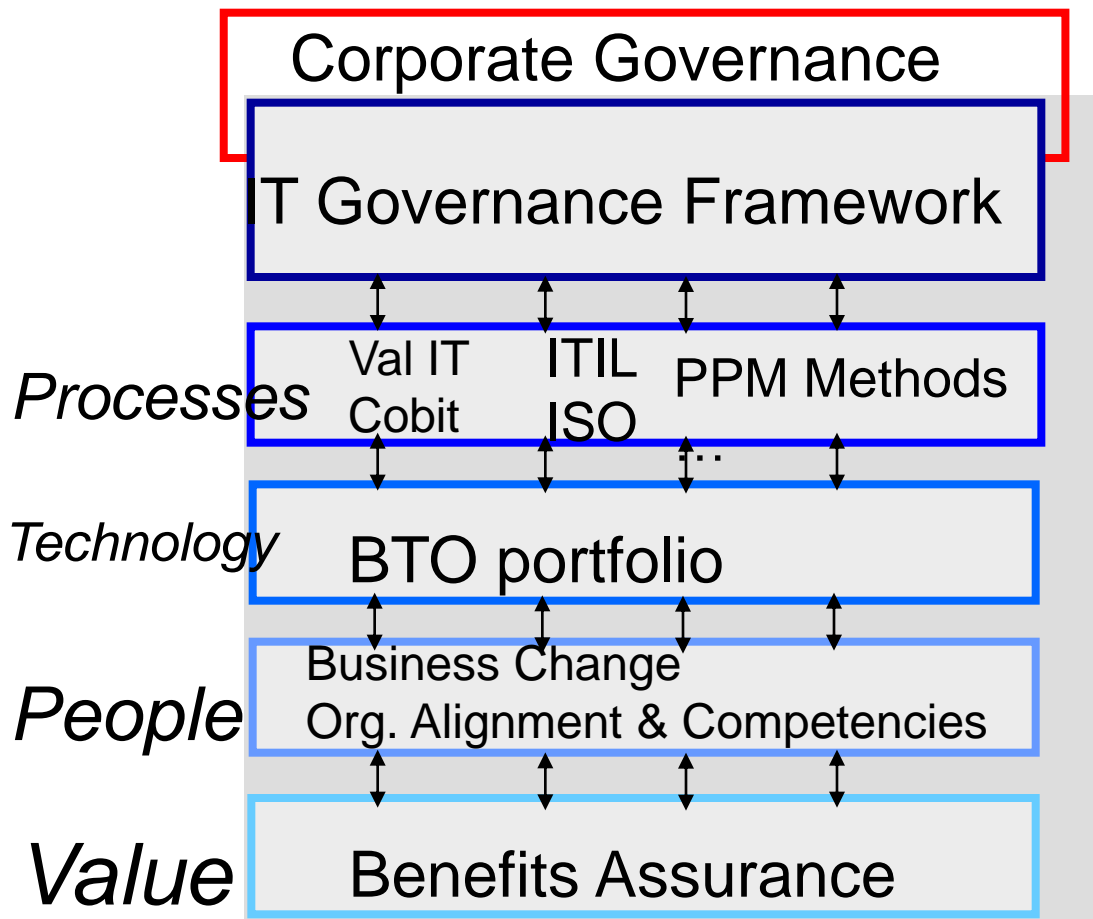

IT Governance Models - the 5 pillars



1. Underpinned by processes that must be implemented
2. Supported by technology
3. Define business change issues to be addressed
4. Define organisational realignment
5. Include some way of measuring the value to be achieved (e.g. balanced scorecard)

The right balance?

Maximize return:

- How do you sustain business growth for high ROI?

Enable agility:

- How does IT enable business adoption to changing customer needs?

Manage risk:

- How do you ensure CIA while growing?

Improve performance:

- How do you improve customer & employee satisfaction?

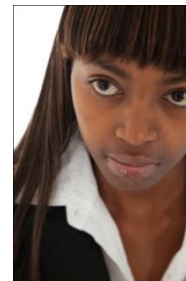
